Note: The one-time enrolment fee of \$5,000.00 is in addition to the tuition fees below.

The 2013-2014 Fee Schedule appears below. Appleby College offers the convenience of three payment plans for the payment of the fees: Annual, Quarterly and Monthly. *Tuition cannot be paid by credit card.*

Select or confirm your preferred payment option on the online Registration Agreement.

- If a plan is *not* selected, the student will be enrolled under the Annual Plan, with full payment due by April 1, 2013.
- **International Students - families must select the Annual Plan and pay all fees by April 1, 2013.**
As well, there is a requirement to provide credit card details to the business office for automated monthly payment of miscellaneous charges to student accounts. Alternatively, please submit \$2,500.00 with the tuition fees to pay for miscellaneous charges incurred throughout the year.

Annual Plan

- Full payment is due by cheque, online banking, wire transfer or Travelex on or before April 1, 2013.
- Tuition Refund Insurance is optional.

Quarterly and Monthly Plans

- Tuition Refund Insurance is included in the fees.
- Pre-Authorized Payments (PAP) are required for the Quarterly and Monthly Plans:
 - If you are already on the PAP plan, you need only update your banking information if it has changed.
 - New parents, please submit a VOID cheque.

1) Steps to set up online banking with Appleby College:

Sign onto your internet banking website.

Add Appleby College as a payee

Use the 7 digit Student ID as the account number

(Note: If there are siblings also attending Appleby you need only set up one account.

The payment will be allocated to the multiple student accounts).

2) Paying via online banking:

Select option to pay bills

Select Appleby College as the payee

Enter the amount you wish to pay

Process the transaction as prompted by your bank's website



International Payments to Appleby College

Appleby College has partnered with Travelex to provide an easy, lower cost alternative to international wire transfers for your tuition payments.

Advantages of using Travelex's Bank to Bank Transfer:

- Easily make a bank to bank transfer by choosing the Travelex link in the registration documents page on Appleby College's website.
- With Travelex's Bank to Bank Transfer, you pay the Canadian dollar tuition fees in the currency of your choice, typically your local currency, which will then be converted to Canadian dollars.
- There are NO transaction charges from Travelex or Appleby College, though you may be charged a transaction fee by your bank. These fees should be less than the international wire fees.
- The exchange rate is valid for 72 hours after you have initiated the transaction.
- The exchange rate is competitive when compared to retail rates of your financial institution and for many families their bank service fees are also reduced due to the transaction being initiated as a local transfer.
- Payments received will include your reference information and will ensure that your payment reaches your student's account quickly.

Steps to make a payment

Step 1: Visit Appleby's website

- Go to <http://www.appleby.on.ca/registration> and click on the link for international tuition payments.

Step 2: Process Payment

- Sign into the secure site and enter your student's information
- Enter amount of Canadian Dollars to pay
- Select your choice of payment currency
- Finalize transaction
- Print confirmation page

Step 3: Bank Transfer

- Take confirmation page to your local bank
- Local bank sets up transfer of funds to Travelex

Step 4: Payment Finalized

- Appleby College will post the Canadian dollar equivalent to your student's account.
